#### **OIE RISE GRANT**

#### **Grant Goals**

- 1) Students and staff benefit from programs and opportunities that focus on academic preparation for college, career, and community leadership, for identity development, and for holistic well-being.
- 2) Funded projects act as "bright spots" for future investment by the ADE Office of Indian Education to expand and/or replicate successful programs based on community needs and desires in Indigenous Education.

## Funded programs will participate in a three-year process

- Year 1: Stakeholders and community engagement, plan development
- Year 2: Implementation plan
- Year 3: Continued plan implementation while building sustainable practices and programs

 What does the Community want to see to transform the education experience of our Native American students?

- Create a logic model with funding for Years 2 and 3.
  - SY 2024-25
  - SY 2025-26
- Budget is \$100,000/year for 3 years
  - Years 2 and 3 will include matching funds from ALA and SRES

- Plans in place for SY 2023-24
  - Community meetings
  - Student travel to visit colleges and other post secondary opportunities
  - Facilitator/Evaluator
  - Culturally sensitive curriculum
  - Post-secondary planning curriculum
  - Literacy items to continue what NYCP started
